Parking in Bellagio

In Bellagio, like all other small towns, parking the car is sometimes a problem. The various maps of the town show parking areas in the centre and nearby.

To help you understand the information more easily, the free parking shown on the maps with green lines have white lines on asphalt in reality and you can leave you vehicle here free of charge, even for several days.

Pay and display carparks have blue lines on asphalt. The price is \in 1.50 per hour and payment applies only from 8 am-8 pm. Payment is made at the automatic machines situated near the parking areas and tickets must be placed where they can be clearly seen on the dashboard, to allow traffic wardens to check that payment has been made. These are denoted on the map by a P on a red background or red lines.



Finally, we would like to remind you that parking areas with yellow lines are reserved exclusively for the use of Bellagio residents and for disabled.

During the Summer and on Sundays all through the year from 10 am - 6.30 pm, the historic centre of the village becomes a pedestrian area and access is controlled by a monitoring system.
